Children's Ministries

NURSERY is offered for infants & children through Kindergarten age. Our nurseries are in the church building's basement. **Infant nursery** for babies, crawlers, and very early walkers.

Toddler nursery for children who are walking up to three years of age. Children who turn three from January-August are invited to attend preschool worship starting September 1. Children who turn three from September-December are invited to attend preschool worship starting January 1.

Preschool worship for age 3 through Kindergarten. Three-year-olds (see above) and four-year-olds are welcome during the whole service. Five-year-olds remain upstairs in the worship service until dismissed at 10:50.

Cono Choir to be at Old Orchard Church

The choir of Cono Christian School, a Christian boarding and day school from Iowa, will perform here at Old Orchard Church at 640 Amelia, Webster Groves on Saturday, March 1 at 6 p.m. Old Orchard is also invited. They have an audience of their own who they are inviting.

The 50-member choir, which sings nationally each year, sings a full range of sacred songs, from gospel music, spirituals, and hymns, to classical choir selections.

The Cono Choir has been performing since the school began in 1951. In recent years, it has sung in 38 states, including at state capitol buildings, at the 7,000-member Coral Ridge Presbyterian Church in Florida, and at the Moody Church in Chicago, besides singing before hundreds of congregations. In Iowa, the choir visits local churches and other venues.

Cono Christian School is a Christian boarding and college preparatory school in Walker, Iowa. Its boarding students have come from nearly every state in the U.S. and from more than a dozen foreign countries.



A Note From the Session

Several have asked over the years if Will Barker could serve Old Orchard as a ruling elder. The answer to that is no, since he is a minister, or teaching elder in our denomination, the Presbyterian Church in America, and teaching elders can only serve on a Session of a church (that has a pastor) if they are called as an associate pastor to that congregation. The concern is that since pastors/ministers (the terms are synonymous) are leaders, too many leader-type guys on a Session who are not actually on the staff and working under the senior pastor might make for power struggles on a Session. For good or for bad, that's our polity (government) in the PCA.

But we figured out a way to benefit from Will's wisdom. We've asked him not to join the Session but to come to Session meetings as an advisor and to give us feedback and counsel as we discuss and debate matters before us. We're happy to report that Will has graciously agreed to do that and has already begun to meet with us. He is not on the Session and cannot actually vote on issues, but we can still benefit from his experience, his knowledge of God's Word and the history of the church, and his heart-knowledge of the Lord of glory. It's great to have Will around! Please thank him for being willing to give his time to the body of Christ at Old Orchard.
