Welcome!

> End-of-the-Year-Contributions

The last Sunday you can drop gifts in the collection plate and have them applied to the year 2008 for tax purposes is <u>Sunday</u>, <u>December 28, 2008</u>. Anything put in the collection plate after that will be counted as part of your giving in the year 2009, even if you back-date the check. IRS rules for tax deductions stipulate that gifts must be given by December 31—in the hands of the church by midnight, December 31, or postmarked in 2008 (if they are being mailed) though not received by the church until 2009.

> OOC Finances

The following recap covers OOC's financial results for the period from July 1 thru October 31 for both 2007 and 2008:

	Receipts/Income	Disbursements/Expenses
2007	\$106,891	\$97,466
2008	\$ 87,682	\$99,894
Difference 2007 & 2008	(\$ 19,209) (decrease)	(\$ 2,429) (increase)

Please note that this \$2,429 increase in disbursements/expenses between years is well within budgetary expectations.

I draw your attention to the nearly 18% **decrease** (represented by the \$19,209) in receipts/income for this year as compared to the same period in 2007. The Session recognizes that many in our congregation are struggling with real or potential loss of jobs. The rest of us are in shock as we view the turbulence of these economic times. Church leadership commits to monitoring this trend very carefully and apart from a reversal will undertake to make the difficult choices to balance this budget. Please be asking the Lord to bring in the money to support the work of his church.
