
No Sunday School during the month of July. We will resume in August.

Personal Care Packets for Refugees

Webster-Rock Hill Ministries provided various trial-sized personal care items that were donated during "April Showers" to them, and that they are not able to make use of with their clients so they gladly gave us boxes full! However, they were not sorted so we had one group sort all these donated so we could see if we had enough to make full packets that the International

Institute asked for. We were almost able to: we were short some toothpaste and had no toothbrushes. The Deacons' Fund contributed \$41.05 toward the expense of getting toothpaste and toothbrushes and threw in some verify inexpensive combs bought in bulk. We have leftover combs and toothbrushes which we hope to find other opportunities to give away.
