## **OUR CHILDREN'S MINISTRY**

❖ **Toddler nursery** for children who are walking up to three years of age. Children who turn three from January-August are invited to attend preschool worship starting September 1. Children who turn three from September-December are invited to attend preschool worship starting January 1.

❖ **Preschool worship** for age 3 through Kindergarten. Three-year-olds (see above) and four-year-olds are welcome during the whole service. Five-year-olds remain upstairs in the worship service until dismissed at 10:50.

❖ **Children's Worship.** For children in grades 1-5. Listen for dismissal announcement.

### **SAFE FAMILIES FOR CHILDREN**

This Sunday's "Moment for Missions" will highlight "Safe Families for Children," a program of Bethany Christian Services. Its coordinator is Kristina Duce. Her e-mail is [kduce@bethany.org](mailto:kduce@bethany.org) and Bethany's phone number 314-781-6363. Here's a brief summary of the program.

**Safe Families for Children (SFFC)** is a network of host families that provides a loving sanctuary where parents may temporarily and safely place their children in times of crisis. Host families serve purely out of a sense of compassion and receive no compensation.

**Mission Statement:** SFFC extends community support by hosting vulnerable children and strengthening their families in crisis through a network of volunteers motivated by compassion.

The SFFC movement is based on the perspective that the safety and health of our community children are the responsibility of each one of us and that parents are the key to providing long-term, safe environments for their children.

**BETHANY CHRISTIAN SERVICES NEWS & TABLE HOST FOR DINNER  
WANTED!**

Dear Church Partner:

God has been at work this year in Bethany Christian Services serving Missouri and Central/Southern Illinois in remarkable ways!! We have seen an increase in the number of pregnant women we are able to walk with as well as an increase in adoptions. Bethany has brought on a male counselor to serve expectant fathers. We have opened a service location in Springfield, Missouri adding a full-time worker. Furthermore, we have launched a new initiative called Safe Families for Children and have seen over 100 children in need of services since mid-July. [Editor's note: see separate article in this issue regarding this.] SFFC will be launched in Springfield, Missouri and Central/Southern Illinois in 2011, as well. YOUR CHURCH has played a significant role in all these occurrences with your partnership.

We are currently preparing for our first annual Fellowship Dinner on April 2nd at 6:30 pm at the Renaissance Downtown St. Louis. The purpose of the dinner is first, to celebrate what God is doing in the lives of people who are touched by Bethany's ministry in our area; second, to cast vision for where we believe God to be taking us to serve more children in our community and around the world; third, to challenge our guests to partner with us financially as we do God's work through Bethany.

As we are trusting God for these things, we need your help in two ways. First, I would like your church to be present at the dinner, and second, I would like someone from your church to serve as a table host.

Being a table host would simply involve committing to fill a table of eight by inviting church friends to join you. You DO NOT have to pay for the table -- just fill it. This will help us tremendously, as we trust the Lord to extend His work through Bethany. By helping in this way we will be able to acquaint more at your church at what God is doing through Bethany Christian Services in our area.
