Our Children's Ministry

Nursery is offered for infants & children through kindergarten age. Our nurseries are in the church building basement.

- Infant nursery for babies, crawlers, & very early walkers.
- **Toddler nursery** for children who are walking up to three years of age. Children who turn three from January-August are invited to attend preschool worship starting September 1. Children who turn three from September-December are invited to attend preschool worship starting January 1.
- **Preschool worship** for age 3 through Kindergarten. Three-year-olds (see above) and four-year-olds are welcome during the whole service. Five-year-olds remain upstairs in the worship service until they are dismissed at 10:50.
- **Children's Worship** will not be meeting through the end of August. Please see Jessie Swigart or Mark Robertson with questions.
- Children's Activity Bags in Worship! Parents, each week there is a new activity sheet for children in the colored bags which are in a box alongside the windows in the back hallway. These sheets are a way to help children engage in worship; if they are not yet reading, perhaps you can assist them after the service with some of the questions, though there are also graphics and games for all to enjoy according to that week's theme. Let me know if you have suggestions, as we seek to help the whole family worship well Sunday mornings!

Format: We gather in the living room around the fireplace, grab some treats, have a short time of singing/worship, then jump into our study. We walk through the questions one at a time in a discussion format. Questions always welcomed! End with prayer. There is usually some time to visit & have more snacks if you want, before you pick up the kiddos. All are welcome. Please invite your friends and neighbors!

Childcare: 2 Nurseries Available (infant/early walkers and toddler/preschool) in the church nurseries (basement of church) kids can be dropped off as early as 9:05 and need to be picked up no later than 11:15. Two childcare workers for each room. All workers have been background checked and have excellent references. Workers each week will be leading your children through a bible story and song, & snack. Also lots of time for free play. If workers need to contact you during the study, you or our childcare coordinator will receive a text. ** Because of budget constraints we will be asking moms to pay a small fee for childcare, amount TBD. (Again, don't let this cost keep you from coming. Please talk to Melissa)

• "Firm Foundation": New City Fellowship (north & south) Tutoring Opportunities: You're invited to spread the gospel to the urban poor through tutoring a student in grades K-12 once a week for 1-1/2 hours. Firm Foundation Tutoring's North City program meets on Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday from 4:15-5:45 for elementary students and from 6:00-7:30 on Tuesday and Thursday for middle school and high school students.
