Children's Ministries During Worship

Nursery is offered for infants & children through kindergarten age. Our nurseries are in the church building's basement.

Adopt a Family for Christmas & More See the tree today in the parlor.

We invite you to help provide for these families and children in Christ's name. We have adopted two families from Webster-Rock Hill Ministries program—providing gifts (represented by red or gold ornaments), food, and if possible utility assistance; providing 10 gifts to children of those who are presently incarcerated (these are paper green and red angels) through the ministry of Mission Gate; 5 cash/check gifts of \$25 each for families in need in Brazil (represented by a paper flag of Brazil); and small gifts \$5 to 10 range (some may be even cost less) for both the three year old we adopted through Webster Rock Hill Ministries, and the children of the ladies served by the Grace & Peace Winter Shelter (represented by the lavender smaller ornaments).

Children in the congregation Preschool through 5th grade are encouraged to take the **lavender** ornaments. (If the smaller ornaments are not all taken by December 2, then anyone (teens or adults) can take a smaller gift ornament.) **Teens:** there are 8 teens signed up for a smaller gift—please consider taking one of those ornaments and getting the gift!

You can also **contribute funds** instead of purchasing a gift and we will use it toward the families' needs (certificate for fresh food or meat, utility assistance, to supplement food or gifts that have been donated, etc.). Please write checks to Old Orchard Church and designate it "Adopt a Family."

We're asking also for non-perishable food items for the families.
