Deacon and a Deaconess Candidates 2009

The purpose of our apprenticeship program for potential elders, deacons, and deaconesses is to train them but also to test them. As has been announced, Denny Reinheimer was nominated for deacon and Donna Knobbe for deaconess.

It's helpful to the Session to get feedback from the congregation early rather than late in the apprenticeship period; so we're asking the fellowship for feedback now as to Denny's and Donna's maturity and gifts.

Their community groups are being given a few questions to answer, but for others of you who know either of them: Do you have any concerns about their readiness for the work of service that should be taken up by the elders? Do you have confidence in each one's maturity?

Of course, if you have a personal grievance against either of them, that should be taken up with Denny or Donna personally, according to our Lord's instructions in Matthew 18:15-17. But if there are any general areas of concern that you think ought to be addressed during the apprenticeship time, please talk with me.
