### Our Children's Ministry

Nursery is offered for infants & children through kindergarten age. Our nurseries are in the church building basement.

❖ **Infant nursery** for babies, crawlers, & very early walkers.

❖ **Toddler nursery** for children who are walking up to three years of age. Children who turn three from January-August are invited to attend preschool worship starting September 1. Children who turn three from September-December are invited to attend preschool worship starting January 1.

❖ **Preschool worship** for age 3 through Kindergarten. Three-year-olds (see above) and four-year-olds are welcome during the whole service. Five-year-olds remain upstairs in the worship service until dismissed at 10:50.

❖ **Children's Worship.** For children in grades 1-5 at Milligan House. Meets during worship, usually at 10:50.

### Bethany Christian Services: Volunteers Sought!

*An article about this program was in the Post-Dispatch last week and posted on the Mercy Ministry bulletin board.*

Dear Friends of Bethany:

We have launched a new initiative called Safe Families for Children. It is a movement to help families in temporary crisis. SFFC provides a safe host home for the children while the parents get this stabilized. This crisis may be the loss of job, hospitalization, homelessness, etc. We have seen such a need in the community and have had to turn down some recent referrals because we need more host homes. If you are someone you know may want to learn more about what's happening in the program, I encourage you to join our Facebook group: Safe Families for Children-Missouri.

There are 4 ways to become involved in the initiative: Host Home--providing a place for a child while the parents stabilize, Family Friend--be a mentor to a momma, Resource Family--provide needed items (may be a bike, a bed, a gas card, etc.), or a Case Coach--transport children to family visits, visit host families to provide encouragement. There are

so many ways to be the hands and feet of Christ with this movement. We have been inundated with referrals--the need is great and the ways are many that you can help.
