# Presbytery-wide Worship Service

Because we believe this exhortation (from Hebrews 10) is critical for all ages of the church we want to extend a heartfelt invitation to all the churches of the Missouri Presbytery and any friends who would like to join with us, to gather together on Sunday night, October 30 from 6-7:15 pm for a Presbytery Wide Worship Service Celebrating the Reformation.

This year's service will be held at **Memorial Presbyterian Church** on Skinker Road just across from Forest Park. The service will be co-led by many local PCA pastor's and musicians and our preacher for the evening will be Dr. Jimmy Agan III, Associate Professor of New Testament and Director of Homiletics at Covenant Seminary. In addition to the ministry of the word we have planned a thoughtful service of worship that will highlight the great doctrines of the Reformation and include the celebration of the Lord's Supper.
