Welcome!

Guests, we welcome you and thank you for coming! We invite you to use our **child care services** for infants through children in kindergarten, located in the church building basement. Please see nursery details below. Sunday School for all ages usually meets at 9 a.m. (except during the summer and some holidays) Please see note below for more.

Our Children's Ministry

Nursery is offered for infants & children through kindergarten age. Our nurseries are in the church building basement.

❖ **Infant nursery** for babies, crawlers, & very early walkers.

❖ **Toddler nursery** for children who are walking up to three years of age. Children who turn three from January-August are invited to attend preschool worship starting September 1. Children who turn three from September-December are invited to attend preschool worship starting January 1.

❖ **Preschool worship** for age 3 through Kindergarten. Three-year-olds (see above) and four-year-olds are welcome during the whole service. Five-year-olds remain upstairs in the worship service until dismissed at 10:50.

❖ **Children's Worship.** For children in grades 1-5 meeting at Milligan House. Listen for dismissal announcement, usually around 10:50 am. See Jessie Swigart or Mark Robertson.

Make Use of the Children's Activity Bags in Worship!

Parents, each week there is a new activity sheet for children in the colored bags that you can find in a box alongside the windows in the hallway. These sheets are a way to help children engage in worship; if they are not yet reading, perhaps you can assist them after the service with some of the questions, though there are also graphics and games for all to enjoy according to that week's theme. Adopt a Family for Christmas & More

We are providing gifts, gift certificates and food for those who are in difficult circumstances and for whom it would be a blessing, and practical help to receive these gifts. The selection include: **(1)** 10 gifts (\$25 range) for children of parents in prison Mission Gate distributes, **(2)** small gifts (\$5 to \$10) to the children/grandchildren of the women who are guests in the Grace & Peace Winter Shelter and **(3)** contributions for small gifts [chapsticks and gloves] for the 16 women served by the Winter Shelter **(4)** providing gifts and food and (as able) utility gifts for two families we're adopting through Webster Rock Hill Ministries). One family of four includes two children ages 12 and 6; the other family is a disabled man.

Ornaments on the tree represent gifts, gift cards, cash contributions. Please take one half of the ornament and get your gift, then leave the other half of the ornament with your name on it with us (in the provided envelope) to tell us you have taken that gift or gift card. Children in the fellowship are encouraged to take a gift for a child/grandchild of the women at the Shelter. Funds are welcomed to help with the gift giving; your check can be written to Old Orchard Church and designated adopt a family. **Gifts & contributions need to be returned by Sunday, December 9.**

Also, we are looking for **donations of non-perishable food** for a Christmas dinner [just think of a traditional meal; we're posting a list WRHM gave us], and other items to help stock the pantries for the two families.
