### **End of the Year Contributions**

The last Sunday you can drop gifts in the collection plate and have them applied to the year 2013 for tax purposes is <u>Sunday</u>, <u>December 29, 2013</u> (next Sunday). Anything put in the collection plate after that will be counted as part of your giving in the year 2014, even if you backdate the check. IRS rules for tax deductions stipulate that gifts must be given by December 31—in the hands of the church by midnight, December 31, or postmarked in 2013 (if they are being mailed).

### **Blood Drive as Gratitude**

Some of you may remember that we prayed this past summer for Emily, the 28 yr.-old niece of our neighbors,

Tim and Kathy Randall, who live right next to the Wilkes. Emily contracted E. coli bacteria and nearly died. But thanks be--truly--to God: she came out of a deep coma, survived, and is doing well now!

Emily received numerous blood transfusions, and so to show gratitude for the tremendous help this was to Emily's recovery, the Randalls and her wider family are hosting a blood drive on **Monday**, **December 30**, **from 2-6 p.m.**, and it is our privilege to serve this family by letting them use our "parlor" (back of the sanctuary) for this public-service effort. The family has invited anyone from our congregation who is able and willing, to join them in this "pay-back" project and give blood on that day.

This is a fine way to show solidarity with our neighbors and contribute something positive to the public good. If you're willing to participate, put it on your calendar now! And thank the Lord that he spared the life of this young woman (a former co-worker of our daughter, Susannah), who had been married just less than a year when she took sick.

Brothers and sisters,

Your elders have called a congregational meeting for **Wednesday**, **January 22**, **at 6:45 p.m.** for the presentation of church officers who are up for election. The roster is as follows:

Matt Philip, first-time candidate, up for the office of elder for a 2-yr. term. Matt's spiritual autobiography will be published and distributed to the fellowship on Sunday, January 5. Matt, nominated last year, has completed the apprenticeship work and desires to stand for this office. The Session, believing Matt to be qualified for it, is willing to lay hands on him and ordain him to the office of elder if you, the fellowship want him to serve you in this way.

Nate McKie & Greg Roig, first elected in 2008, are both up for their 3rd term for the office of elder (it would be a 3-yr. term). Greg and Nate have served the fellowship well as elders, and the Session is willing to have them continue in this office, if that is the will of the body.

Please review the qualifications for the office of elder as set out in the Word of God (1 Timothy 3:1-7; Titus 1:5-9; 1 Peter 5:1-4), and then talk with these brothers and their wives about the work of an elder--their availability for it, their desire to do it, their insights into what it means to give spiritual oversight to the body of Christ. And above all, be in prayer that the Lord would continue to give us, and bless us with, godly leaders.
